Note: A rider showing deliberately a movement of higher degree of difficulty than the Intermediate I Test , will receive a 0 for the whole movement and the scores for choreography as well as the degree of difficulty cannot be higher than 5.

For example; A rider deliberately showing more than single pirouettes (i.e. more than 360 degrees) will receive a 0 for the whole movement and the scores for choreography as well as the degree of difficulty cannot be higher than 5.

A rider deliberately showing a movement of higher degree of difficulty not mentioned in the Intermediate I must be eliminated immediately. For example: Sequences of flying changes at every stride, showing piaffe or passage
